THIS MONTH

In November, students completed their study of Quadrilaterals. They learned how to prove a quadrilateral was a special type of quadrilateral and the properties rectangles, parallelograms, squares, rhombi, trapezoids and kites have.



Students finished an in-class look at finding a missing plane in a formation of planes flying in a parallelogram. We discussed this problem as a class instead of writing a problem-solving paper about it.

Students in December began to work on their review for their midterm final exams.
